- ✓ Meet with your FSS Coordinator on an on-going basis; review plans.

## WHAT IS FSS?

The Family Self-Sufficiency (FSS) Program is a voluntary program and is designed to assist families and individuals in becoming financially independent.

You will receive supportive services from community resources.

These services are available to assist you in transitioning from where you are now to where you would like to be in the future.

The FSS program is up to five (5) years and can be extended to two more years and is available to all Daytona Beach Housing Authority Families.

## WHAT CAN I EXPECT?

Families will create a financially empowered future by choosing to work on goals with their FSS Coordinator such as:

- \*Education
- \*Career
- \*Entrepreneurship
- \*Financial, and other asset-building goals.

There is also a financial incentive to the program. As your earned income increases, your portion of rent may increase. The program may match a portion of that increase rent into an **escrow account** for you.

If you reach your goals, you will be awarded those funds, tax free, at the end of your participation in the program.
